Painting Centenary Service *Sunday, 22nd September 9.30am*
This special service of morning prayer at St. John's, led by lay members of the congregation, will celebrate the hundredth anniversary of the war memorial painting on the east wall of the church. The painting is dedicated to "The glory of God and in memory of all faithful departed, especially those who gave their lives in the Great War 1914-1919". So our prayers, hymns and bible readings will both celebrate the glory of God in his creation and remember the men of Helsington killed in the war. In place of a sermon, readers will tell the story of how the memorial came to be painted, speaking as three of those involved in its creation. This will be a unique occasion in the history of Helsington church.
