

Crosthwaite Traffic Management Improvements

The Parish Council has been consulting with Cumbria County Council Traffic Engineers about reducing speed limits and improving road safety in the village. The accompanying map shows their proposals.

We now wish to receive the views of parishioners on these proposals.

If the work is to go ahead, we understand that CCC do not have any funds to finance it and we would need to raise the money from grants and donations.

The estimated cost of the work, prepared by the council, is summarised below. County Councillor Jim Bland thinks that this estimate is excessive and plans to discuss the project with county council staff in order to obtain a more realistic estimate.

So, currently, the cost of delivering this proposal would be between £9,200.00 to £10,000.00, This comprises:

- 1- Site Survey £500
- 2- Traffic Regulation Order Exercise (TRO) £3000 (This is obligatory and involves official procedures and official consultation with the public.
- 3- Preparation of a Signing and Road Marking Design Drawing (AutoCAD) £1500
- 4- Cost of Signs and Posts £1700
- 5- Installation Cost £2500

Regardless of these costs, the Parish Council would like to obtain the views of parishioners before taking the project further. The simple question is – “would you like to see these changes take place?”

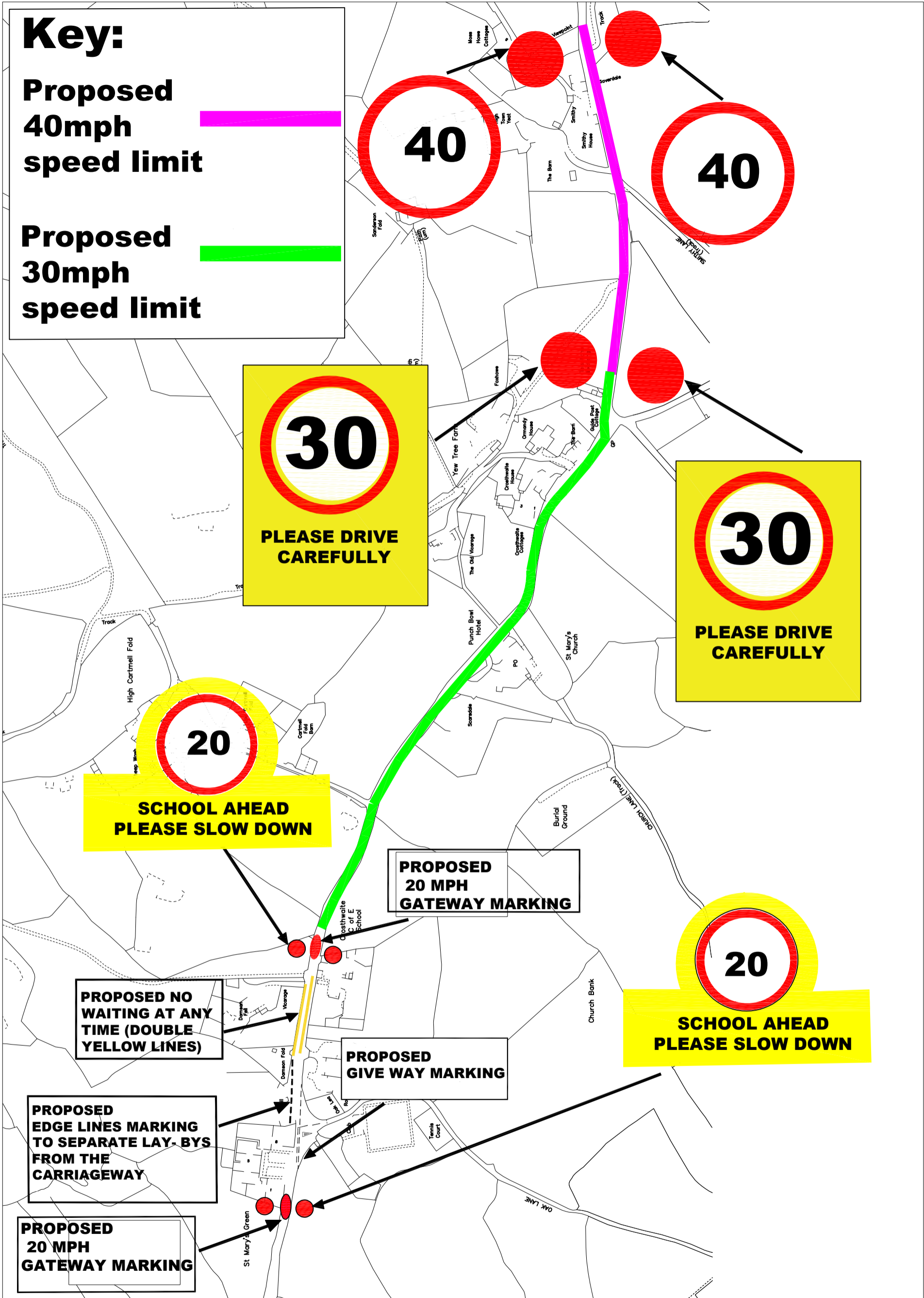
